

PARTICIPANTS CODE OF CONDUCT

The Participants Code of Conducts applies to all Boro6 Sports participants. This code applies to players as individuals or as a team, and the penalties can apply to any individual or an entire team. This code becomes effective as soon as participants arrive at the field/facility of play and remains in effect until the participants leave the field/facility.

The purpose of the Participant's Code of Conduct is to promote a safe and fun environment for all participants in the Boro6 Sports community. All Boro6 Sports participants should exhibit ethical, respectful, and sportsmanlike conduct. Boro6 Sports celebrates diversity, equity, and inclusion, and prohibits discrimination based on race, sex, religion, national origin, age, sexual orientation, and gender identity.

No Participant Shall:

- 1. Express any derogatory, discriminatory, or unwelcome comments based on or in reference to race, sex, religion, national origin, disability, age, sexual orientation, or gender identity.
- 2. Engage in any physical or verbal sexual harassment. Sexual harassment is unwanted, unacceptable, inappropriate, or offensive behavior of a sexual nature that affects the dignity of another player and creates an intimidating, hostile, unstable or offensive play environment.
- 3. Lay hand upon, push, shove, strike or threaten an official, employee, participant, or spectator.
- 4. Endanger the safety of any official, employee, participant, or spectator.
- 5. Refuse to abide by an official's decision.
- 6. Demonstrate objectionable behavior or dissent at an official's decision by throwing equipment or any other forceful action.
- 7. Discuss with an official, in any manner, the decision reached by such official (exception is made for team captains).
- 8. Verbally or physically abuse any official for any decision or judgment.
- 9. Verbally or physically abuse any participant.
- 10. Engage in overly physically play or use unnecessary rough tactics against another participant.
- 11. Discuss publicly in a derogatory manner any play, decision, or personal opinion of other participants.
- 12. Smoke at any indoor facility or within the playing area of any outdoor facility.
- 13. Possess or consume alcohol prior to the start of any game, during a game or at a facility/field.
- 14. Appear in an intoxicated condition at a field/facility being used by Boro6 Sports.
- 15. Display a lack of respect or care for facilities.
- 16. Knowingly engage in illegal activities.
- 17. Play under another individual's name, falsified name, or falsified address on an official roster.
- 18. Promote any product or competing league to officials, employees, participants, or spectators.
- 19. Purposely disregard Boro6 Sports, LLC league rules.

In addition, [participants are liable for damage to equipment or the field/facility.

Not following the Participant's Code of Conduct could result in penalties such as:

- 1. Warning by the official.
- 2. Ejection from the game.
- 3. Suspension from games without refund.
- 4. Removal from the league without refund.

All participants must be on the roster and where applicable must sign the waiver (the only exception will be in a situation where individuals don't register but rather a team captain registers their entire team; in this situation, the team captain agrees prior to finalizing the team registration that he/she will share the Participant's Code of Conduct with on players on their respective roster) prior to participation or be subject to game forfeiture or disqualification.
